From the Principal

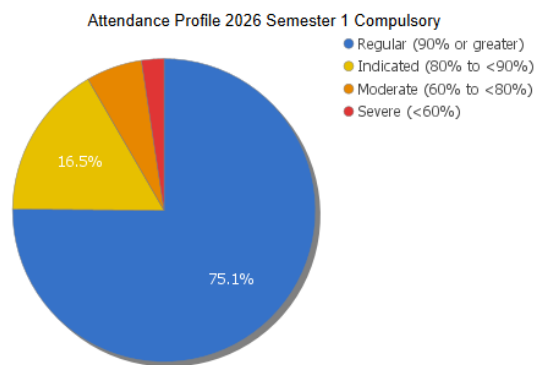
Monday 20th & Tuesday 21st April are School Development Days, when staff undertake professional learning and students do not attend. We will be commencing our school journey in 'Real Schools,' in an endeavour to build a healthier school culture through restorative practices. Along with 'Real Schools' we will also spend time on 'Boys in Education,' researching methods that best work for our boys. Our data analysis shows our boys are lagging behind in many of our metrics including academic achievement and negative behaviour.

Here's some good news. At the beginning of this year we made a commitment to dramatically improving attendance rates, including employing an Attendance Officer and so far, so good. Attendance has increased from 86.0% last semester, to 91.8% this term. We currently have 75% of children attending at a regular rate (90%+), compared with 48% last semester.

And finally, this week marks the end of Erin Bates' time as our School Officer. Thank you for 15 years of dedication and care for our students and enjoy that European vacation!

Ride to school day we saw all the creative designs people came up with to decorate their bike for a prize! Thank you to all that entered.

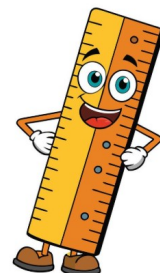
