Welcome back to Term two from the School Dental Therapy Clinics!

Students are eligible to access the School Dental Therapy Centre from the year they turn 5 until end of Year 11/17<sup>th</sup> Birthday. We offer a free service to all schools in the Goldfields area and surrounding regions. In recent years due to staff shortages we have had clinics closed, students normally feeding in to these clinics can access treatment from South Kalgoorlie Dental Therapy Centre Tuesday to Friday and Boulder Dental Therapy Centre Monday to Friday.

We are very excited to welcome Therapist Iris Chuang to our team until September 2024, she is joining us from Queensland Health and will be working from the Boulder Dental Therapy Centre.
