From the Principal

This week sees the continuation of our fortnight long swimming lesson block. 70% of Pre-Primary to Year Six students have participated and while this is a healthy response, in the spirit of participation, I'd like to see that grow further next year. Schools function effectively through having a predictable routine and the swimming lesson fortnight certainly tests us out on this front, with students having to adjust to a different school day, either through attending lessons or working in another class. The lessons and travel to and from the pool accounts for about a third of a child's school day. Swimming lessons are a vital part of our school curriculum but I'm certain teachers are looking forward to resuming business as usual from next week.

Improving overall attendance has been a focus this year, with the rate dropping below 87% last year and needing to be addressed. 90%+ is the bar we set for regular attendance and we have 65% of our students attending at this rate or higher. While there has been some improvements, with the overall rate at 90%, I'm concerned with some pockets of severe non-attendance that critically affects a child's school performance. The Year Six attendance rate is also not where I would like it to be, as we prepare them for the high school years. At the next school board meeting we will look at processes to improve and promote good attendance. You can find your child's attendance rate on the 'Compass Dashboard.' Have a check and see if their attendance is at the expected rate. Everyday counts.
