


Kindergarten 2026 Enrolments

'YouthCare' provide the chaplaincy service for many of our schools in this district and this was an occasion to both celebrate their service and bring our school community together. We have been fortunate enough to have the expertise and caring nature of Mrs. Cynthia Payne throughout the last 10 years. Cyndi is ever present and available as a friendly caring chaplain for our children to talk to. A job well done to both 'YouthCare' and Cyndi.

At the end of last week we sent home notes for our upcoming swimming lessons. Learning to swim is an essential part of the Australian way of life and I encourage you to send your children along, even if they're reluctant. Not every child knows what's good for them!

One of the complex parts of teaching is to provide for the varying ability levels within a class. Teachers are well-versed in differentiating, but as a school we also need to provide further intervention outside of the classroom. Towards the end of last term Math and English intervention groups were set up to provide additional small group work for those students in Year 1 and 2 that need a little extra. Along with this, we have our 'MiniLit' for the junior students and 'MultiLit' for the older ones, to support progress in Reading and Spelling. We're in a fortunate spot to have the expertise of our education assistants in delivering these programs and supplement the work teachers do in the classroom - thanks team.
