From the Principal

This week the school administration is meeting with individual teachers to discuss student progress. As a school, we have selected a number of common assessments that we implement and then analyse the results. This analysis is used both as evidence to support our grading of students, and to identify concepts and skills we need to revise. From this, teachers have plans for improvement for the remainder of the school year. As principal, it's very satisfying to see first-hand the professional and analytical approach of our teaching staff and the collection and analysis is something we do very well. Next year, I want to share the results of these assessments with parents throughout the year, so that you have a better understanding of what progress looks like for your child. As a school we'll provide families with guidance on how you can assist with this progress on the home front.

Recently we have been developing our new Business Plan 2025-2028. A priority in this plan is to further increase the level of intervention and extension programs and assist those needing additional support , along with striving for excellence in our more academically talented students. As it stands, we have a number of highly successful interventions programs and strategies but the need for this grows. This term we have commenced with small group tuition in Mathematics for some Year 3-5 students. Mrs. Jan Rowling will be applying her expertise with groups of 6-8 students twice per week and building their capacity with basic number facts. Jan will also be conducting "Writer's Workshops" to extend and enrich the writing of our more talented students.

I'm looking forward to an energetic and wok focused term for all of our classes and students.
