

In Term Swimming Lessons

For those children who have enrolled and paid for swimming lessons, they are commencing **Monday 3rd August to Friday 14th August** and will be held at the Goldfields Oasis. Please see the timetable below for the times of their lessons. The bus will leave the school to travel to the pool 20 minutes before the commencement of each lesson.

- Students in **lessons 1 and 2** are to wear their bathers under their school uniform. If they are in **lessons 3 – 6** they can bring their bathers and get changed at school before the bus leaves.
- Please ensure your **child packs the following each day**: towel, goggles if desired, underwear, thongs to wear to the pool, and a sturdy bag to transport their dry clothes to the pool and then place their wet swimming gear into at the end of their lessons.
- **If your child has asthma** they will need to take their medication to the pool every day. Alternatively, if medication is not required whilst swimming, please provide the school with a written note stating that medication is not required whilst swimming before your child attends their first lesson.
- Classes in **lesson 2** will not be at school in time to purchase any recess and will therefore need to bring a **packed recess each day**. Classes in **lesson 3** will have an early recess break before attending swimming lessons and will therefore need to bring a **packed recess each day**.
- The Oasis has asked us to remind parents to please remain in seating areas during lessons and not disturb the teachers. If parents have any questions, please meet with the centre supervisor (red bib) after your child's lesson.

Please be aware children cannot attend swimming if payment hasn't been received prior to the commencement of lessons.

Safe at Home

- ☐ Join the waitlist for additional programs if desired.

October programs

(Close: Wednesday 19 August 2026)

- ☐ **October program:** Wednesday 30 September to Friday 9 October 2026 (8 days)
- ☐ **October short:** Monday 5 October to Friday 9 October 2026 (5 days)

Summer programs

(Close: Wednesday 14 October 2026)

- ☐ **Country early start:** Saturday 19 December to Wednesday 23 December 2026 (5 days)
- ☐ **January program 1:** Tuesday 5 January to Friday 15 January 2027 (9 days)
- ☐ **January short:** Monday 11 January to Friday 15 January 2027 (5 days)
- ☐ **January program 2:** Monday 18 January to Thursday 28 January 2027 (8 days)

Class Photos/Portraits:

- * Every Student will have their photo taken, whether they are purchasing photos or not.
- * The school has chosen to use the online ordering system. Your child will be given an online ordering instruction slip and a unique student **shootkey**.
- * Log onto www.msp.com.au and follow the prompts to place your order.
- * If you lose your **shootkey** the school reception will have a copy to quote back to you.
- * The expiry date for online ordering is **Sunday 9th of August 2026**
Any orders received after this date will incur a \$30.00 archive fee.
- * Spare order envelopes (green) will be available at the school reception if you prefer to pay with cash.

Specialty Group Photos:

- * After photo day, a link will be sent to the school for distribution to parents whose child/children is/are in the specialty group photos.

Family Photos:

- * Envelopes (orange) can be obtained from Administration.
- * Family photos are taken each morning before school.
- * Please ensure that your family envelope and payment are handed to the Photographers on photo day.
- * If you do not have the correct money we will provide any change needed when photos are delivered to school.
- * Family photos **cannot** be ordered online.
- * Once school has received photos, family photos will remain at reception for parents to collect.
