lessons finishing and an amazing NAIDOC day.

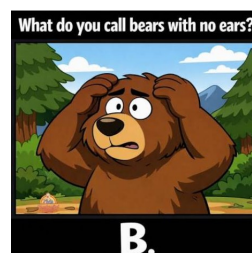
