From the Principal

As we move towards the end of the 2025 school year, our aim is to finish strong and make every school day matter. Quite often I'll hear talk of "well it's only the last week of school, so it doesn't matter" (note—these words sometimes come out of my own children's mouths!). We only have 40 weeks of school per year, so yep the last week or two does matter. While programs may look a little different (take for example the photos alongside), the learning is still taking place.

Teachers are finalising Semester Two reports and they will be sent out on Tuesday of the last week. Our grades are based on a variety of in-class assessments, school-wide assessments and teacher observations. An interesting point raised at our last Board meeting came after a presentation of school wide assessments from our Early Childhood team. Board members were impressed with the depth of assessment and analysis and wondered why we don't share this with families. So in 2026 we'll look for a method to share this progress and achievement as they take place, so that come report time, you already have a good understanding of how your child is performing.

Other things to look out for in 2026, as per our new Business Plan (coming soon to a good school website near you), will be a beefed up attempt to tackle declining attendance (currently at 86% compared to 91% in 2019) and strengthening our intervention and extension programs. We will employ an Attendance Officer and direct teaching and education assistant time to better cater for the range of ability levels.

Just a reminder that the end of year concert is on **Tuesday, December 9th 2025**. We can't wait for everyone to 'wow' us with their dance moves.

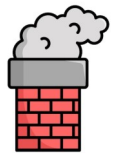
