Mid year recruitment is now a more regular event, with teaching opportunities no longer arising only at the beginning of the year.

Currently the numbers are at an all time low, with only 20 having been received. Generally we have an enrolment of 45-60 students. Progressive Achievement Tests Later this term Years 2-6 students will undertake this 'Australian Council of Educational Research' assessment in Reading and Mathematics. It provides us with rich information on student performance compared against Australian norms, along with highlighting what needs to be taught or reviewed in term 4. The testing presents as similar to NAPLAN. If you would like to know how your child has performed then check with their teacher towards the end of term.

New furnishings at our recent finance meeting a submission was passed to purchase new desks and chairs for the Addis St block. We like our classrooms to be maintained in a neat and organised state, and this is part of the ongoing rolling out of resources.
