Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome to Year 2/3 Room 16! My name is Mrs Caroline Kelly and I am very excited to be teaching your child this year. This is my ninth year as a teacher at North Kalgoorlie Primary School, teaching years one through to three during that time. This is the fifth time that I have also taught a split year level class.

In 2022, I achieved the Departments Level 3 Classroom Teacher status, which is a formal recognition of outstanding teaching practise. Part of my role as a L3CT is that on Thursday I am the whole school Mathematics Curriculum Lead Teacher where I will be providing maths support and coaching to students and other staff members. Every Thursday for 2023, Mrs Sarah Chidlow will be the classroom teacher.

Siren Times

Homework

It is anticipated that Homework will begin in Week 2. Homework will consist of daily Home Reading, as well as Spelling Word Practice and short Maths activities. Home Reading books will come home in the large pencil cases supplied on the personal items list. They will be swapped on Fridays to give children time to re-read books to build fluency over the week. Children can also read books from home. All other homework tasks will come home in a folder and it will consist of activities for children to do over the week.

Behaviour Management

It is whole school policy to use 1-2-3 Magic to encourage and support positive behaviour. This is used in conjunction with whole school practices such as merit certificates, GOTCHAS and Blue Letters.
