

1:1 BYO iPad Program Participation Survey For Years 4 - 6 in 2019

Years 4, 5 and 6 children in 2019 will be able to participate in our voluntary BYO iPad program in which they are able to bring an iPad to school for them to use in their learning.

In order to allow us to plan effectively for this program and ensuring it has the best impact on children's learning, we are taking a quick survey of parents to determine how many iPads we might expect to be brought to school next year.
